

REACH Declaration of Compliance

REACH regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 ensures a high level of protection of human health and environment as well as the free movement of substances, on their own, in preparations and in articles, while enhancing competitiveness and innovation. This Regulation should also promote the development of alternative methods for assessment of hazards of substances. This requires all actors in the supply chain to communicate information concerning the safety use of chemicals. Especially, organizations that manufacturer or import articles contained substances of very high concern (SVHC) have compliance obligations.

We are currently in the process of screening our suppliers for compliance per REACH requirements, in particular concerning the constraints applying to the substances listed in Annexes XIV and XVII of the Directive.

When applicable, articles that contain SVHCs from the REACH candidate list (substances of very high concern) at a concentration greater than 0.1% (w/w) will be indicated in the article list (incl. names and CAS numbers of the SVHCs).

We perceive our information duty in the supply chain after Article 33 of the Directive and are therefore committed to inform our customer as promptly as possible about any changes or issues related to REACH compliance.
